Arlington 20/20 Initiative Overview

Arlington 20/20 is a community transformation initiative created in 2015 that seeks to serve the residents of the Arlington community, promote development within Arlington, and change the narrative regarding Arlington. Together, Arlington stakeholders developed the following 20-point plan as a framework for action to make positive, measurable impact in five focus areas: community empowerment, economic development, family strengthening, housing development, and workforce development.

Arlington 20/20 Goals
Community Empowerment
Disseminate positive news, communications, and volunteerism opportunities
Identify and address 50 most pressing blight cases
Implement community safety strategies in rental communities
Increase positive interactions and positive perception of JSO within community
Increase volunteer and donor support mobilized to area
Mobilize church congregants to love and serve community in tangible ways
Economic Development
Establish business incubator
Facilitate City Council passage of Community Redevelopment Area
Facilitate mixed-use development of Town & Country property
Improve motorist, pedestrian, public transportation, and bike access to businesses
Update infrastructure (water, sewer, electrical, lighting)
Family Strengthening
Create service hubs within Arlington Manor and Woodland Acres neighborhoods
Increase access to preventive care and healthy foods
Housing Development
Create pathways to home ownership for first-time homebuyers
Increase number of affordable, quality senior housing units
Workforce Development
Create pathways to employment success among hard-to-place populations
Identify and support quality early care and education options
Implement parent education/mentoring strategies for academic achievement
Increase free and low-cost high-quality afterschool options
Increase involvement of parents and community members in schools

Arlington 20/20 Partnership

While the governing and fiscal agent for Arlington 20/20 is Revitalize Arlington, Inc., a 501(c)(3) nonprofit CDC founded by Impact Church in 2006, the direction and strategies of the initiative are developed collaboratively with its partners including faith-based organizations, community-based organizations, businesses, community residents, and government entities. All Arlington 20/20 partners support the goals of the 20-point plan and are collaborating in various ways to support its implementation in alignment with their missions.
